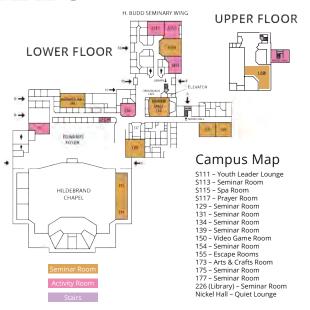

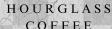

## YOUTH WORKER RESOURCES

If you are here as a youth worker, you are giving up your weekend to help point students to Jesus and we are so thankful for that. These sessions are focused on connecting you to other youth workers and incredible content just for you.

#### **OPTION SESSION 2 – THE LANDING**

### Sid Koop & Rob Chartrand - Building a Resilient Life

A discussion on ministry leaders' high turnover by focusing on cultivating resilient faith through life-structuring habits that deepen one's relationship with Christ for a more fulfilling ministry. We will also explore methods to pass these faith-forming practices onto the youth, ensuring longevity and impact in ministry work.

### **OPTION SESSION 3 - RM 226 (LIBRARY)**

#### Sid Koop - Re-thinking Identity

Due to societal pressures, students feel weak and uncertain when facing identity challenges. In contrast, the Gospel offers a path of finding identity through God and others first, promising true freedom. Our goal is to develop a youth ministry that guides students to become resilient, compassionate, and truly free individuals.

## **OPTION SESSION 4 – RM 226 (LIBRARY)**

## Rob Chartrand - Getting the Gospel

Understanding the true essence of the gospel is crucial for a solid foundation in both our lives and ministries. We will tackle common misconceptions and "pseudo-gospels," aiming to clarify the genuine core of the gospel and its profound implications for personal life and ministry work.

## Cecily Brennan – Empowering Youth Leaders: Navigating & Equipping for the Complexities of Adolescent Mental Health

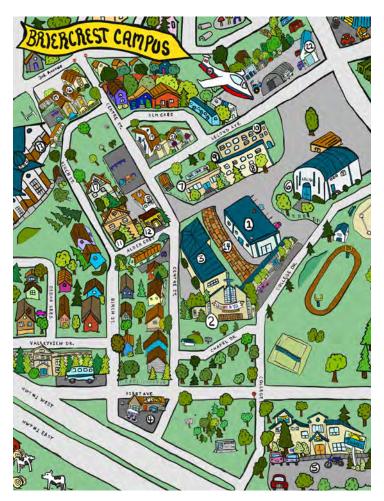
